Due to misinformation being spread on social media we would like to make a statement to clarify information about the 146th Independence Day Parade.

1. The ribbon cutting to formally begin the parade will take place at the corner of N. Locust and E. Washington just as it has many times in years past. The parade lineup will still take place at the school and neighboring streets. However, this year it will also include part of N. Locust due to the expanding

size of the parade and safety with the overflow from the side streets that continue to spill out on larger traffic streets (Elm and Pine, etc.).

2. You are still able to toss and hand out candy-just as you have every year of the parade. The statement from the parade application covers throwing candy and must be included for insurance purposes and protection of the Chamber of Commerce. This activity will continue as it always has as part of the annual parade!!!
3. The parade will still follow the same route and will not be skipping any of the streets that the route has covered in recent years.
