Nonprofit Builds Barn at 937 N Marshall

Brooks and Family Equine Retirement (BFER) is completing construction and fencing on a 9-horse barn just north of the fairgrounds at 937 N Marshall Street in time for its official grand opening over Harvest Days, September 20-21, 2025. The public is encouraged to come by to see the barn and the horses and to enjoy brats,

burgers and drink—while supply lasts.

BFER is a nonprofit community resource: horse hospice for gentle old and disabled horses who are available for touch therapy with persons with disabilities, the elderly, Veterans, children in general, and others. Although not officially open to the public until September 20, the horses have already been providing joy to local residents with disabilities in partnership with WC Partners and CC Rising, as well as to neighboring children and people from upstate and out of state.

BFER is a 503(c) charity run on the former farm of Charles A and Wilma Brooks, grandparents of Executive Director Sherrie (Brownstein) Hall. Her husband, Jeff, who is Farm Manager, has designed the new barn and been co-General Contractor with Dean's Excavating. BFER's board of directors includes Paula Thompson of WC Partners; Katie (Newcomb) Hawkins, well-known for her prior work with the Springfield Human Society; Erie, PA Special Olympics Executive Director Katherine Reim; Human Resources Director over medical staff of the Missouri prison system Jessica Wilhelm; 2024 St Louis business person of the year, Kelly Annis; Provider Partners Health Plan Clinical Operations Manager Betsy Nelson, RN/NP; and Angela Roark, longtime director/employee/volunteer of the Missouri Wildlife Rescue Center.


