Marshfield Remembers Event



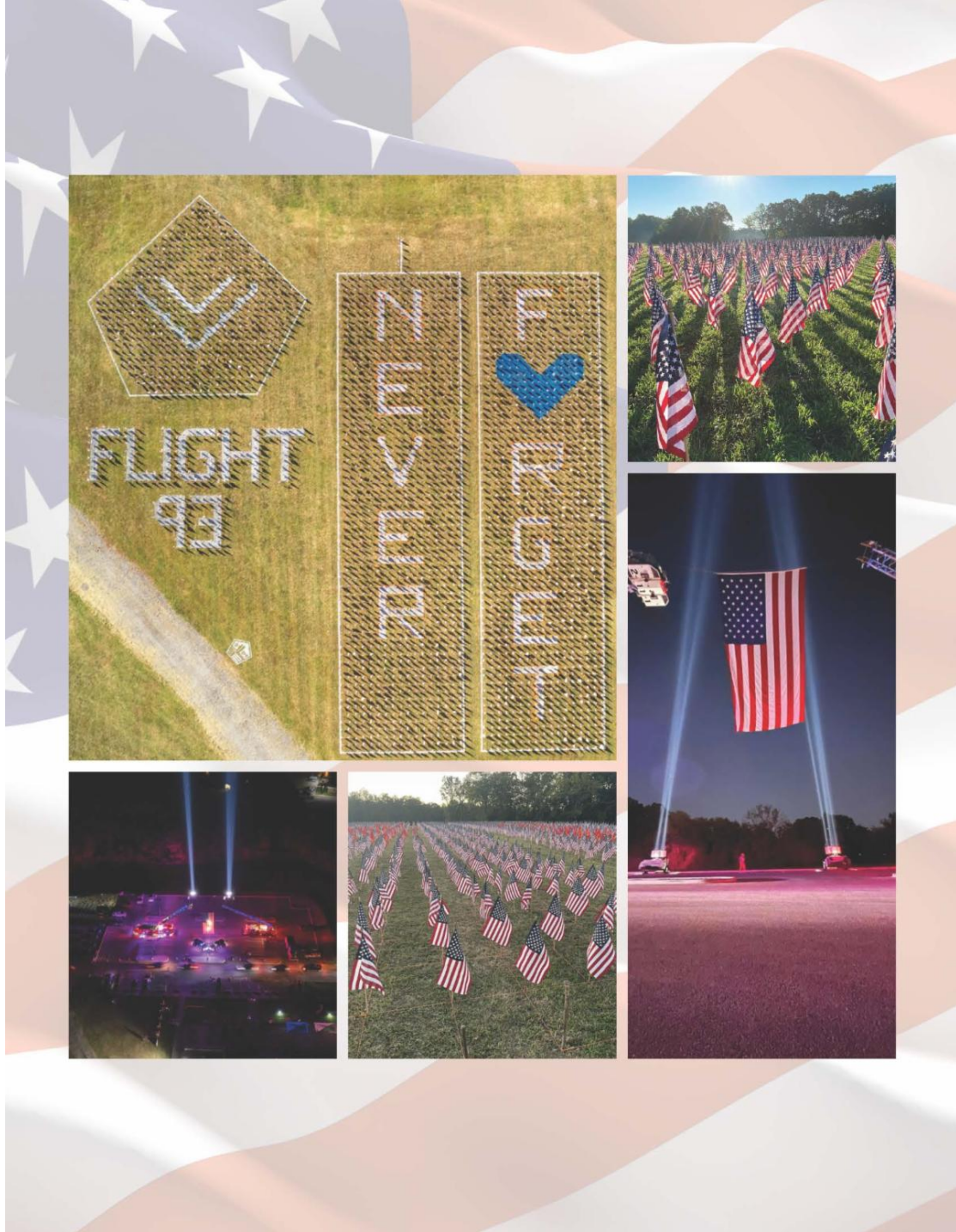
WE WILL NEVER FORGET.

Our employees place 2,977 individual flags in Patriot Park each year to represent the lives lost 24 years ago.

In addition, a light tribute will begin at 8:00 P.M. with two towers of light shining in the night sky for exactly 102 minutes to be followed by the playing of Taps at 9:15 P.M.
