## HONOR FLIGHT *of the* OZARKS

### Our Story

**Honor Flight of the Ozarks founded in 2013 was organized with one mission: to take local U.S. Armed Forces veterans who served honorably during World War II, the Korean Conflict, the Vietnam era and the Gulf War to Washington D.C.** They visit the World War II Memorial, Korean Memorial, the Vietnam Memorial Wall, Air Force and Marine Corps Iwo Jima Memorials and Arlington National Cemetery including the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Since Honor Flight of the Ozarks started we have taken over 2100 veterans to Washington. Last year we took 237, all at no cost to the veteran. Guardians who accompany the veteran pay \$600 each.

The trips to Washington D.C. include roundtrip nonstop travel on chartered aircraft from Springfield to Washington, D.C., bus transportation, police escorts, breakfast, lunch, dinner, hats, t-shirts, and a backpack filled with travel incidentals. Honor Flight of the Ozarks is one of over 140 individual Honor Flight hubs located all over the United States and is an IRS 501 (c) 3 tax exempt charity with all donations being tax deductible. Honor Flight of the Ozarks receives no government funding. All funds must be raised locally. It is expensive with the three flights this year costing us about \$600,000.

Veterans who live in Southwest Missouri and Northwest Arkansas are eligible to go on an Honor Flight through this hub. Veteran, Guardian and Volunteer applications are available on the website [Honorflightoftheozarks.org](http://Honorflightoftheozarks.org).

# SBA Disaster Relief Notice: Apply by Feb. 20, 2026

## Grace Period for Physical Damage Loan Applications Ends Soon!

The President's major disaster declaration for severe storms, straight-line winds, tornadoes and flooding in Missouri occurring in March 30 through April 8, 2025, includes a 60-day Grace Period for filing physical loan applications due to the scale of the disaster. **This grace period ends on Feb. 20, 2026** – submit your application before it's too late!

No appointment is necessary.
