Ice melt and rock salt are great at one thing:  
lowering the freezing point of water so ice and  
snow melt faster. A+ chemistry  
But what they don't teach on snow days  
Salt + concrete = long-term damage,  
especially if the concrete is new.

Science class: Salt is hygroscopic meaning it  
pulls moisture into concrete. That moisture gets trapped in the pores.  
Freeze-thaw cycles make it expand, causing scaling, pitting, and flaking.  
New concrete (<12 months) hasn't fully cured yet, so it's even more  
vulnerable.

When temperatures warm up, rinsing your concrete removes leftover salt  
before it keeps doing damage. It's one of the most cost-effective ways to  
prevent deterioration and extend the life of your concrete.

Final answer:

Salt melts ice fast.

Leaving it behind fails the class.

No homework. Just rinse. Class dismissed.
