MARSHFIELD, MO (November 2025) — Marshfield Community Theatre (MCT) is celebrating the season in true holiday style with the return of its Holly Jolly Holiday Pageant, part of the theatre's annual Holly Jolly Holiday Weekend. Registration is now open for participants of all ages to showcase their talents, stage presence, and festive spirit at The Jubilee Theater this December.

The event includes two separate pageants — one for youth and teens and one for children — providing opportunities for everyone from toddlers to high school seniors to shine on stage.

Winners in each division will be crowned, with 1st Runner-Up and 2nd Runner-Up also recognized. Additional special awards will be presented for Talent, Holiday-Inspired Formal Wear, and Congeniality. Contestants may also submit a headshot to enter an optional Photogenic category.

Winners will receive a special invitation to ride on the MCT float in the Marshfield Christmas Parade that evening at 5:00 p.m.


