MARSHFIELD, MO – The Webster County Health Unit invites community members, partner organizations, elected officials, and members of the media to attend a ribbon cutting ceremony celebrating the **Rest Easy Naloxone Project** on **Tuesday, September 1, at 11:00 a.m.** at the **Conway Travel Center- East**

Launched on May 6, the Rest Easy Naloxone Project is an innovative community partnership designed to make the opioid overdose reversal medication **naloxone** readily available to travelers passing through Webster County along Interstate 44. In just a few short months, the project has already distributed **more than 430 boxes** of the lifesaving medication, demonstrating both the need for and the value of increasing access to this proven overdose intervention.

The project places free naloxone in an easily accessible location where travelers heading both eastbound and westbound on Interstate 44 can obtain the medication without cost. Naloxone is a safe medication that rapidly reverses the effects of an opioid overdose, restoring breathing and providing valuable time until emergency medical services arrive. Public health experts agree that widespread access to naloxone saves lives and is one of the most effective tools available in addressing the ongoing opioid overdose crisis.

The Rest Easy Naloxone Project represents the power of collaboration among organizations committed to improving the health and safety of Missouri communities. Partners include **APO Community Health Center, Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT), Webster County Health Unit, Community Partnership of the Ozarks, Southwest Missouri Drug Poisoning Coalition, Missouri Hospital Association, and The Naloxone Project.**

"This project is about meeting people where they are and ensuring that a lifesaving medication is available when it counts," said **Ashley Dedmon, MEd, Drug Free Communities Project Director for the Webster County Health Unit.** "More than 300 boxes have already been distributed since May, showing that travelers recognize the importance of being prepared to respond to an overdose emergency. We are incredibly grateful for the commitment of our partners, whose shared vision has made this innovative project a reality."

Dedmon adds, "Naloxone is not just for individuals struggling with opioid use disorder. Family members, friends, first responders, businesses, and everyday citizens can all play a role in saving a life. Having naloxone readily available is no different than having a fire extinguisher or an automated external defibrillator (AED) - you hope you never need it, but when you do, it can make all the difference."

The Webster County Health Unit encourages the public to attend the ribbon cutting ceremony to learn more about the project, recognize the collaborative partners who made it possible, and celebrate an initiative that is already making a meaningful impact across southwest Missouri.

Ozarks Homesteading Expo Returns to Marshfield for Labor Day Weekend

The Ozarks Homesteading Expo will return to Marshfield September 4-5, bringing thousands of homesteaders, farmers, gardeners, families and people interested in greater self-reliance

together for two full days of hands-on education, demonstrations, speakers, vendors and community.

Founded in 2019 by Cheryl Franklin, the Ozarks Homesteading Expo was created to bring together people who want to learn practical skills, connect with others and become more capable of providing for themselves and their families.

What began as an experiment has grown into one of the region's largest gatherings focused specifically on homesteading and self-sufficiency.

"This has always been a labor of love," said Franklin, founder of the Ozarks Homesteading Expo. "We want people to come to the Expo and learn something they can take home and actually use. But just as importantly, we want them to find community. There is something pretty special about gathering people who still want to grow their own food, raise animals, preserve what they grow, learn old-fashioned skills and take responsibility for the things they can control.

The 2026 Expo will feature more than 120 homesteading-themed vendors, along with educational sessions covering a wide range of topics including gardening, livestock, food preservation, food freedom, homesteading skills, off-grid living, foraging, mushrooms, hog and poultry processing and more.

Attendees will also have opportunities to watch demonstrations and learn from experienced homesteaders, farmers, authors and educators.

The Expo's speaker lineup includes nationally recognized voices as well as experienced people from the Ozarks and surrounding region, giving attendees an opportunity to learn from people who have spent years putting these skills into practice.

The Expo also serves as a meeting place for a growing community of people interested in food independence, gardening, livestock, preservation, traditional skills and rural living.

For some attendees, homesteading means a large farm and livestock. For others, it may mean a backyard garden, learning to can food, raising chickens, installing an off-grid water system or simply becoming more prepared and self-sufficient.

Franklin said that diversity is part of what makes the event special.

"You don't have to have 40 acres to be a homesteader," she said.

"You don't even have to call yourself a homesteader. If you want to learn how to grow something, preserve something, make something or provide something for your family, there is something here for you."

Because the Expo falls on Labor Day weekend, organizers are encouraging visitors to make a weekend of their trip and explore the Ozarks while they are in the area.

But first, Franklin said, stay for church. A old-fashioned tent church service will be held on Sunday morning at 9 a.m. at the fairgrounds. You don't have to have a ticket to attend.

The Expo will be held at the Webster County Fairgrounds on Friday, September 4, and Saturday, September 5, 2026. The gates open at 7 a.m. and sessions start at 8 a.m.

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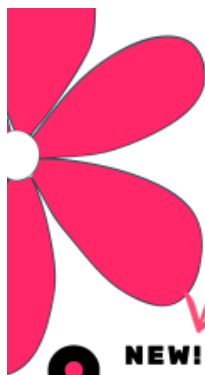
